The goal of the paper

- n The main data source of the research is the results of the local government self-evaluation survey conducted by the Latvian Statistical Institute (LSI)

Self-evaluation survey of local governments

- Latvia the second country in the Europe what organizes it
- 14 years experience of the LSI in conducting business tendency surveys
- First local government self-evaluation survey in 2005, second – 2007
- Local government self-evaluation survey in Latvia full survey
- Response rate in 2005 100% (530 municipalities)
- n Response rate in 2007 99% (522 municipalities from 526 municipalities)

Peculiarities of the local government self-evaluation research

- Includes several branches of the economy such as education, culture, health care, social activities, public utilities, and administration
- Includes also questions of sociological character on the problems that are important for the local governments
- Complex analysis of the qualitative indicators of local governments
- Inclusion of open-ended questions abot problems and best pracctice

The main principles of the selfevaluation of local government

- Concentration of information
- n Evaluation of retrospective forecasts and comparing with reality
- n Accumulation of data and comparison accross the time series
- Openness of the aggregated information and confidentiality of individual data
- n Continuing development of the research programme

Qualitative information

- The conjuncture surveys are carried out with the aim to provide users with information for short-term analysis and forecasts. The surveys are simple. They do not require quantitative information.
- The source of self-evaluation of local governments is the answers provided by the heads of local governments to qualitative questions on the socio-economic situation, its changes, present and future trends, as well as limiting factors.

Structure of questionnaire

- n Employment (6 questions)
- n Economy and finance (9 questions)
- n Quality of local government performance (12 questions)
- n Activity of population (3 questions)
- n Local government reform (5 questions)

Objects of sub-questions

- n Schools
- n Pre-school establishments
- n Health care institutions
- n Social care
- n Cultural institutions
- n Public utilities
- n Administration
- n Other sectors
- n Local government in general

Balance of answers

- n Balance of answers is used as indicator
- The balance of answers with three options is calculated as the difference between the percentages of positive answers (increase, above normal, etc) and negative answers (decrease, below normal, etc)
- n The special formula is used for questions with more answers

Culture – the highest priority in the programme of the survey

- Special role of culture in second survey
- Special chapter in the questionnaire comprising the questions which are connected with culture both in broad and narrow sense
- 38 qualitative indicators characterising the situation and trends of culture (of 110 indicators in total)
- n Traditional quantitative statistics are also used in analysis
- Preparation of new research programme at present
- The LSI has envisaged population survey that will include questions on cultural issues, too

Official quantitative statistics on culture

- The official statistics in Latvia provide the users with the main quantitative indicators of cultural institutions.
- n Information on culture includes:
 - n number of libraries, collections, the number of users and loans
 - number of culture houses, amateur performing units and participants there
 - n number of museums and admissions (state, municipal and accredited private museums)
 - n number of theatres, performances and admissions
 - n number of cinemas, cinema shows, film production by kind of films
 - TV and broadcasting companies, the number of programs broadcast

Libraries

- The number of users of the National Library in 1990 was 19,9 thousands and in every next five years has increased about 10 thousands, reaching 52,4 thousands in 2005
- The collection in the period 1990-2005 in the National Library decreased by 8%, loans increased by 13%
- The number of public libraries decreased from 1317 in 1990 to 877 in 2005, the collection by 46%, number of urban users by 51%, number of rural users by 10%, number of loans in cities decreased by 4,8 million units, in rural areas increased by 2,0 million units

Other data on culture

- There was sharp decrease in the number of culture houses, amateur performing units in culture houses and participants in amateur performing units in the period 1990-1995, but there are little improving of two latest indicators in the next 10 years till 2005
- Although the number of museums stayed at the same place in the period 1990-1996, the admissions decreased 3,1 times. Beginning 1997 there is increase of both indicators, particularly the number of admissions
- The tendency of development of production of magazines and other periodicals as well as newspapers, relating to number of tittles and annual circulation in the period 1990-2005 is the same as production of books and brochures


